Science Technician

The person appointed will have the ability to work on their own initiative and in an organised manner.

They should have good written and verbal communication skills. Knowledge of computers and commercial software packages is desirable. Ideally the person appointed will have some experience of working as a school science technician; otherwise, they should come from a scientific background or have good scientific knowledge.

A pleasant disposition and the ability to relate well to pupils and colleagues are essential.

The person appointed should be flexible and able to adapt to new challenges. The ability to work to deadlines and to work well under pressure are necessary qualities.

They should be willing to work as part of a team and cover colleagues should the need arise. A good sense of humour would also be an asset.
